# City Budget

The City of Dearborn's consolidated budget is **\$196,370,845** and includes the general fund, which is made up in large part of property taxes

and pays for the majority of the services delivered to you every day; plus federal and state grants for community improvements, operation of five senior citizen apartment buildings; state-shared taxes for highway repair and resurfacing; and water-sewer fees collected and paid to the City of Detroit.

## City Services: 33.5 cents of your tax dollar

The City of Dearborn uses property tax dollars to provide high quality and comprehensive services to residents and businesses. Those City services are offered using just 33.5 cents of every dollar the City collects in property taxes. (The federally-mandated combined sewer overflow (CSO) debt millage equates to 7 cents of every dollar and is outlined separately here.) The other 59.5 cents of every tax dollar the City collects in property taxes is directed to other public agencies, like Wayne County and the public schools. Although the City is the collecting agent, it has no authority over how the 59.5 cents is used by other public agencies.

## Friends of the Rouge



The Rouge River is a significant natural feature in Dearborn, and the Dearborn-based nonprofit Friends of the Rouge is the protector of the waterway. In addition to its daily work of water testing and public education, the organization deploys hundreds of volunteers each year for the Rouge Rescue. In 2012, **they removed more than 17,000 gallons of trash from the river and planted more than 4,000 flowers and shrubs at 41 sites** across southeastern Michigan.

# Public Service Days

Keep parked vehicles off the streets 8 am – 4 pm  
every trash day April – November

## When are Public Service Days?

Public Service Days occur on every trash day in your neighborhood beginning in April and lasting through November. On your trash day during those months, you must keep your parked vehicles off your neighborhood streets from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

## What does the City do on Public Service Days?

Public Service Days allow the City to provide services like trash pick up, street sweeping, tree trimming, sewer maintenance and loose leaf collection in a safe, effective manner.

## What are my responsibilities on Public Service Days?

**You must keep your parked vehicles off the street from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on your neighborhood's Public Service Days, even if your trash has already been picked up.**


**You could be ticketed if you park on the street during Public Service Days in your neighborhood. Your vehicle may also be subjected to towing.**

**You also must keep your trash cans, yard waste containers and recycling carts off the street during Public Service Days, and throughout the year.**

In addition, it is your responsibility not to park on the street in other City neighborhoods during their Public Service Days.

## Snow Removal

### Move Parked Vehicles Off The Street When Plows Are Out

Snow plowing is more effective and safer when parked vehicles are off the roads. So you should remove your parked vehicles off the street each time a heavy snowfall is predicted. If the City declares a snow emergency, then you **MUST** remove your parked vehicles from the street or you could be ticketed and your vehicles could be towed. Police do not issue warnings.

In general, a snow emergency will be declared when it is predicted that snowfall will exceed 3 inches or more over a short period and other weather conditions are unfavorable. Remember, City ordinance prohibits parking across the sidewalk at any time.

## Keep Your Grass Cut to Six Inches Or Less

City ordinance requires property owners to regularly cut their grass and control weeds.

Grass must never be higher than six inches.  
Failure to follow this rule will result in penalties.

# Rules For Trash, Recycling & Yard Waste

Please review the rules below to successfully take advantage of the City's comprehensive curbside collection of trash, recycling and yard waste.

## Rules for the Trash Cart

(Use city-issued gray cart)

- **Trash must be bagged and placed inside the gray carts. It can't be loose inside the carts and it can't be placed directly on the ground. Trash in cardboard boxes will not be picked up.**
- Do not overfill the cart or pack the trash in too tightly. Always keep the lids of your cart closed.
- Residents who regularly put out excessive trash and recycling material that spills out of their cart will be required to lease an additional cart for \$55.
- On infrequent occasions, you may place additional items in appropriate containers or plastic bags for pickup. Do not put garbage bags on top of the gray cart.
- Do not put hot items such as charcoal/coins/ash in your cart. Residents will be fined for melted carts.
- Other items not allowed in the trash carts include (partial list): explosives/fireworks, radioactive materials, animal remains, paint, solvents, glue, car batteries, automotive parts, tires, acids, anti-freeze, gasoline, gas cans, transmission fluid, disposable LP gas tanks, chemicals, oil, household hazardous waste, pesticides, medical waste, exposed needles, cement, sand, rocks, bricks, soil, infectious waste, poisons, asbestos, shellac, tar, tree stumps, tires, large amounts of remodeling or demolition materials.

## Rules for the Recycling Cart

(Use city-issued green cart)

- **Curbside recycling is mandatory in Dearborn. Recycling pickup is every other week.**
- The lid of your green recycling cart is stamped on the outside with either an "A" or "B". Recycling is every other week, according to your "A" or "B" week schedule. The schedule is found on page 27.
- Items that can be recycled are: cardboard, paper bags, junk mail, paperboard, newspaper, magazines, phone books, office paper, cans made of steel, tin and aluminum, kitchen cookware, plastic jugs (No. 1 and 2), household plastic (No. 3 – 7), plastic bags and glass.
- **Do not put Styrofoam, garbage, compost, food, animal waste, electrical cords, tires, or wax-coated paper milk or juice cartons in your recycling cart.**

## Rules for Collection Day

- Place carts on the easement, between the sidewalk and the curb, spaced three feet apart after 5 p.m. the night before collection day or by 7 a.m. on trash collection day. The handles of the cart should face the house. The serial number side should face the street.
- **Do not put your carts in the street.**
- Do not place your carts where they'll be blocked by anything, including parked cars, trees, utility poles or fire hydrants.
- Remove your empty carts from the curb by midnight at the end of your trash day. Store them on your property. Try to keep them out of sight from the front sidewalk and away from your neighbors' houses.

## Rules for Bulk Items

Place your bulk/oversize items for disposal at the curb prior to 7 a.m. on your trash pickup day. A separate truck will pick up these items by the end of your trash day.

### Acceptable bulk items include:

- Household construction material that is bagged or bundled and weighs 35 pounds or less. Limit 5 per week or 20 per year.
- Household furniture. Large move-outs do not qualify.
- Household appliances. Doors must be off refrigerators and freezers.
- Carpet/padding. Cut and tied (or taped) in 4 foot rolls. Carpet must be rolled, tied (or taped) and weigh no more than 35 pounds each. Limit 6 rooms a year.
- Windows (up to 4 x 6 feet. Limit 5 a week or 20 a year), garage doors (up to 8 x 8 feet).

## Rules for Special Pick-Ups

- Large set-outs of bulk items require a special pick-up. Please call 943-2433 for more information. A minimum charge of \$55 will apply.
- Private contractors are responsible for hauling away their own debris. Roll off Dumpsters may be required, at the homeowner's expense.

## Household Hazardous Waste Disposal

The Wayne County Department of Environment will host several household hazardous waste drop off days in 2014 in area communities. For information, call (734) 326-3936.

- **Never set hazardous material at the curb. It is dangerous to do so.**

## 2014 Holiday Collection Schedule

## Rules For Disposal at the DPW Yard

**The DPW Yard, 2951 Greenfield, is open 8 am – 1 pm the third Saturday of each month** for disposal of items not picked up at the curb. You must be able to move the objects from your vehicle to the disposal site.

**A partial list of materials not accepted at the DPW yard includes:** fuel, tires, ammunition, refrigerators, microwaves or other appliances and hazardous materials. Call 943-2085.

## Rules for Curbside Yard Waste Disposal

**The curbside yard waste program runs from March 17, 2014 – December 12, 2014 (weather permitting).**

- Yard waste includes grass clippings, weeds, leaves, and shrub/brush trimmings. Remove dirt from roots.
- Do not mix fruits, vegetables or animal droppings with your yard waste.
- Place grass, leaves, weeds and garden waste into yard waste paper bags or in your own 20 – 32 gallon container. Containers must be clearly marked with a yard waste sticker. Free yard waste stickers are available at all Dearborn libraries, the Public Works Yard and the Mayor's Office.
- **Do not use plastic bags or cardboard boxes for yard waste.**
- Dirt and sod are not acceptable as yard waste.
- Yard waste (limbs, brush, debris) must be cut into 4 foot lengths and bundled using biodegradable material and must weigh less than 35 pounds.
- No more than 20 yard waste containers or bundles of brush will be picked up per household, per week.
- Private contractors are responsible for hauling away their own debris.
- Yard waste should not be blown or swept into the street
- Unbundled or improperly bundled brush requires a special pickup. Call 943-2433.

# WRONG



**Do not overfill your carts.** If this happens regularly, you will be asked to lease an additional cart for a one time fee.



Carts should not be placed in the street.

# RIGHT



Carts should be placed three feet away from each other, with handles facing the house, and placed on the easement. **Do not put them in the street.** Avoid obstacles. Lids should be closed.
