Plumbing and Sewer Tap Permits

Information and Permit Application City of Dearborn

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Contractors must be licensed by the State of Michigan and registered with the City of Dearborn.
- Permits for projects in public rights-of-way may be issued to licensed contractors only.

MAIL-IN INFORMATION

- Mail-in applications are encouraged. Follow these easy instructions:
 - Obtain application from City of Dearborn web site (Permits) or obtain a form from the permit office. Fill out permit application completely.
 - A homeowner trade permit allowed with proof of ownership and proof of ID (i.e. Driver's License or State ID).
Home owner must live in the home or intend to live in the home in order to obtain a trade permit application.
 - Include a check, payable to "City of Dearborn" for the amount of your permit.
 - Minimum Permit Fee is **\$80** & Administrative fee (**nonrefundable**) is **\$40**
 - Enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope.

PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

- Plans are not required for the following:
 - One and two-family dwellings containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
 - Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be minor in nature.
 - Work completed by a government subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.
- Plans are required prior to permitting for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act. No. 299 or Public Act of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal.

HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT

By signing this application, homeowners are certifying that the plumbing work described on this permit application shall be installed by him/her self in their own home in which they are occupying, or intend to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the current State Plumbing Code and shall not be enclosed, covered up, or put into operation until it has been inspected and approved by the plumbing inspector.

Homeowners also certify that they will cooperate with the Plumbing Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for inspections and necessary repairs.

Special Note to Homeowners: Homeowners are discouraged from obtaining permits on behalf of a contractor. The City of Dearborn cannot resolve unlicensed/ unregistered contractors work deficiencies. The City of Dearborn addresses code issues with the permit holder.

PLUMBING INSPECTIONS - Inspections are scheduled by calling the Automated Inspection Scheduling System at (313) 943-2400. Enter your permit number (i.e. 12-1234) and select the appropriate inspection code below. Permits only include 1 rough & 1 final inspection. Special arrangements for already scheduled inspections may be made the morning of the inspection between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. by calling (313) 943-2155 and talking with a Plumbing Inspector.

SEWER TAP INSPECTIONS

Sewer Tap and related pavement repair inspections are performed by the **Engineering Division** and are scheduled by calling the **Engineering Division at (313) 943-2145** at least **24 hours in advance**.

- A copy of your sewer tap permit will be forwarded to the Engineering Division. The Engineering Division is located on the 3rd floor of City Hall/West Annex (4500 Maple).
- Please refer to the Sewer Connection Standards, Building Lead Requirements and Concrete Pavement Standards for detailed information to assist you with your sewer tap project.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit will expire if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized Work/project is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN THE PERMIT HAS EXPIRED, NO WORK HAS BEEN PERFORMED AND NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. ONCE A PERMIT IS CANCELLED IT CANNOT BE REINSTATED OR REFUNDED.**

REFUNDS: A refund request form must be submitted to the permit office. Forms can be obtained from the Permit office or on line at "cityofdearborn.org" under permits. A refund processing fee of \$25 will be charge for processing. All refunds will be made to the person identified as the permit holder in all cases. Refunds are primarily made on requests when no work or inspections have been performed and the permit can be cancelled. **PERMIT CANCELLATIONS (Contractor Termination) ARE DISCOURAGED:** If an installation is partially completed, then the permit holder (or property owner) shall submit a **PERMIT CANCELLATION** request form. An inspection will be required to determine the level of work completed. The enforcing agency will determine the need for a new permit to complete the work in progress. In most of these instances a new permit will be required and based on the inspection a determination will be made on requiring a new permit be issued and any fees that may apply in order to complete a final inspection.
