Dearborn residents reminded of noise ordinance regulations as summer party season begins

DEARBORN, Mich. – As the season for graduation and other summer parties gets underway, Dearborn residents are reminded of the city's ordinances regarding noise levels.

The goal of the ordinances is to ensure a balance between the rights of people to use their own properties and the rights of their neighbors to enjoy the use of their properties, too.

Please note that city zoning ordinance requires that noise in residential areas not exceed 60 decibels from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.; not exceed 55 decibels from 7-10 p.m.; and not exceed 50 decibels from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
