RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS BAZZY AND SHOOSHANIAN – To table the Ordinance.
7. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS ABRAHAM AND SAREINI – Renewing a cooperative contract with W.W. Grainger, Inc. (C.R. 9-476-11) for one year in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 for Miscellaneous Hardware Supplies and requesting immediate effect.

8. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS BAZZY AND SHOOSHANIAN –
Renewing a cooperative contract with Zuniga Cement Construction, Inc. Increasing the contract with Asplundh Tree Expert (C.R. 12-583-13) in the amount of \$23,478, bringing the new contract total to \$53,478 for Tree Removal Services and Emergency Tree Removal Services and requesting immediate effect.
