RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS SAREINI AND O'DONNELL – Accepting the FEMA-SAFER Grant in the amount of \$1,795,092 for the hiring of additional operational Firefighters and authorizing the Finance Director to recognize and appropriate the grant funds; also authorizing an appropriation in the amount of \$30,000 from the General Fund fund balance to the Fire Department budget, which will then be transferred to the Information Systems Fund for the purchase of radios for the six additional Firefighters and requesting immediate effect.

RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS O'DONNELL AND SAREINI – Declaring a moratorium on the validity and enforcement of the provision in Section 5-1337(j) of Ordinance No. 17-1569 which require a permit for temporary event signs, which are no larger than six and seven-tenths square feet, in commercial zoning districts and requesting immediate effect.
