9. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS O'DONNELL AND BYRNES – Authorizing a cooperative contract purchase from Michigan Cat, through the MiDeal Program, in the amount of \$111,728.14 for a Caterpillar Mini Excavator and a Trail King Air Trailer and requesting immediate effect.
10. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS BYRNES AND O'DONNELL – Authorizing a cooperative contract purchase from Jack Doheny Company, through the Sourcewell Contract, in an amount not to exceed \$446,058.38 for a new Vactor Truck and requesting immediate effect.
11. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS BYRNES AND HERRICK - Renewing the contract with Lower Huron Chemical and Supply (C.R. 10-485-19) in the amount of \$100,000 for Janitorial Supplies, with a new expiration date of October 12, 2021 and requesting immediate effect.
12. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS SAREINI AND HERRICK – Authorizing additional expenditures for D/A Central in the amount of \$25,057.26, bringing the total contract amount to \$45,852.26, for the Purchase and Installation of Security Cameras at the DPW Yard and Public Service Lobby and requesting immediate effect.
13. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS HERRICK AND BYRNES – Renewing the City's membership with the Conference of Western Wayne (CWW) in the amount of \$11,278 for FY2020/2021.
14. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS HERRICK AND BYRNES – Authorizing the Mayor to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the Wayne County HOME Consortium defining the City of Dearborn's membership and participation for the three (3) year period from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2023 and requesting immediate effect.

15. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS BAZZY AND BYRNES – Accepting the State of Michigan Dispatch Grant in the amount of \$1,250,000 with no local match, to provide funding towards equipment and training costs related to the Dearborn United Dispatch Center; also authorizing the Finance Director to recognize and appropriate the funds and requesting immediate effect.
16. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS HERRICK AND BYRNES – Approving the FY21 Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Overtime Enforcement Grant from the Office of Highway Safety Planning in the amount of \$22,915, with a local match of \$5,729 in order to assist with traffic safety issues within the City; also authorizing the Finance Director to recognize and appropriate the funds and requesting immediate effect.
17. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS HERRICK AND SAREINI – Authorizing the Finance Director to recognize and appropriate a federal grant from the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$20,642 to be used for law enforcement related purchases, non-budgeted overtime, equipment and technological improvements.
18. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS HERRICK AND BYRNES – Authorizing the Finance Director to increase the Fire Department position control by one (1) part-time .70 FTE to coordinate and schedule the smoke alarm installs, which will be funded from the 2019 Federal Emergency Management Agency, Assistance to Firefighters – Fire Safety and Prevention Grant and requesting immediate effect.
19. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS BYRNES AND HERRICK – Authorizing the Finance Director to recognize the revenues from the DTE Energy Efficiency Program, in the amount of \$1,550, in the Library Fund.
20. RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS HERRICK AND ABRAHAM – Approving to amend and extend the Council Resolution (C.R. 6-231-20) granting authority to administratively approve temporary outdoor service areas in response to COVID – 19 related restrictions on businesses until January 3, 2021; also approving to waive all fees for permits related to heating elements for outdoor service areas and requesting immediate effect.
