RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS HERRICK AND BYRNES – Approving Change Order No. 7 with CDM Smith Inc.(C.R. 7-472-09, 3-121-10, 6-328-10, 3-139-11, 2-52-15, 5-228-15, AND 8-417-16), in the amount of \$398,125 for the Combined Sewer Overflow Control Project, Job No. 10-04-081 and 04-06-066; also authorizing the Finance Director to establish the CIP Project – Caisson Abandonment and Site Restoration at Caisson Site C2 and appropriate \$420,000 to fund the project; also authorizing the City Engineer to execute the change order on behalf of the City and requesting immediate effect.
