5-318-09. WHEREAS: Ric-Man Construction, Inc., the contractor for the City's CSO Contract C8, has requested that the City allow it to work around the clock with double shift at Contract C8 site, starting from the week of May 4, 2009, and

WHEREAS: The request is based on results of additional investigation that has confirmed the need to closely monitor the shaft sinking operation during this critical period as it descends through very soft clay. This request will be for a limited duration of approximately one to two weeks at which time normal operation will begin, and

WHEREAS: The only equipment that will be used during this period is two shaft hoisting cranes. The decibel noise range (dBA) of the equipment will be tested prior to implementing this plan, but it is expected to be in the intermittent 60 to 65 dBA range, and

WHEREAS: This is a very important phase of the shaft sinking prior to reaching the hard pan and the City Engineer recommends that the request be approved on the condition that the City may revoke this approval should the noise level become a public nuisance; be it

RESOLVED: That City Council hereby authorizes Ric-Man Construction, Inc. to work around the clock with double shift at the CSO Contract C8 site for approximately one to two weeks starting on May 4, 2009; be it further

RESOLVED: That City Council hereby authorizes the City to revoke this approval should the noise level become a public nuisance; be it further

RESOLVED: That this resolution be given immediate effect.
