NOTICE OF PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT
TO HUD CONSOLIDATED PLAN
FISCAL YEARS 2021-2025**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Dearborn, Economic Development Department (EDD) proposes to amend its U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Five Year Consolidated Plan (Con Plan) for years 2023 through 2025 to reallocate and to amend its Annual Action Plan (AAP) for year 2022-23 to reprogram Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the original projects to different projects identified in the table below. This notice is to allow citizens to review the reallocation and reprogramming of the CDBG projects and the funds associated with them.

In accordance with Consolidated Plan requirements at 24 CFR Part 91 Subpart B and the City’s Citizen Participation Plan, EDD has posted the changes to the Con Plan and AAP through this Reallocation and Reprogramming Amendment in order to provide opportunity for public comment.
