

## DEARBORN WATER & SEWERAGE DIVISION SERVICE FEES

### **AFTER-HOURS SERVICE CALLS:**

There is a \$100 charge (Monday through Saturday) and \$125 charge (Sundays and holidays) for all residential and commercial off-duty/after-hours service calls. This does not apply to calls reporting water main breaks, hydrant problems, or other primary system problems.

### **SERVICE DISCONNECTIONS/RECONNECTIONS OF EXISTING WATER SERVICE LINES:**

There is a \$500 charge for disconnecting 3/4" to 2" service lines and a \$650 charge for disconnecting 3" or larger lines. All disconnections requiring pavement removal shall include a pavement replacement charge of \$1,445 for city streets and/or \$2,000 for state and county roads. All reconNECTIONS will be treated as new taps with related procedures and charges.

### **SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT NO-SHOW:**

There is a \$25 charge for no-shows on scheduled appointments.

### **FROZEN OR LOST METERS:**

The owner of any premises where a meter is installed shall be held responsible for its care and protection from freezing or damage by hot water and from injury or interference by any person. The owner of any premises where a meter is installed shall be liable for the full replacement costs of any 5/8", 3/4", 1", 1½" and 2" meter that has been damaged or lost. For meters larger than 2", the property owner shall be liable for applicable repair or replacement costs.

### **SERVICE SHUT-OFF/TURN-ON CHARGES:**

Whenever the water is turned off from any premises at the request of the owner or occupant or because of a violation of any ordinance, rule, or regulation of the City by the owner or occupant thereof, the sum of \$50 will be applied to the water bill to cover the labor cost; and, in cases where extraordinary labor is required, such additional sum as will compensate for such additional labor.

### **HYDRANT RELOCATION:**

There is a \$2,300 hydrant relocation service fee for a property owner or contractor request. Additional fees may apply for concrete replacement on state or county roads. The relocation of a public fire hydrant can only be requested in the case of remodeling an existing structure or new construction. Any relocation of a public fire hydrant must be approved by the Fire Department, Engineering Division, and Water/Sewerage Division and meet all presently existing standards and requirements of our City ordinances and fire protection codes. These fees are to be paid upon application of the request.

### **HYDRANT THAWING:**

There is a \$500 fee per hydrant for thawing a privately owned fire hydrant.
